PROBLEMATIC SUBSTANCES

This is hazardous waste usually generated in a household. Examples are: engine oil, lubricants, paints, adhesives, poisons, solvents, gas cylinders, fire extinguishers, medicines, chemicals

Glow-discharge lamps and batteries

can also be dropped off at the collection site for problematic substances

Old cooking fats and oils

such as lard, oils from pickled or fried foods are not problematic substances. They should, however, be dropped off separately.

Large Electrical Appliances such as washing machines, dryers, electronic cookers, dish washers




