Practical information:

Transportation

The best way to arrive to Graz is by airplane to Graz airport, which is located not so far from downtown. The distance from airport Graz to the hotel Das Weitzer is about 9 km. You can take a public bus from the airport to the city center or to the main railway station in Graz (bus routes 630/631 → http://www.verbundlinie.at/busbahnbim-auskunft/pdf/j13/stv_00u613_j13.pdf). The bus stop is right outside the passenger terminal, right next to the arrival area. Once you are at the city centre (Jakominiplatz) or the main railway station, you can take a tram (No. 1,3,6,7) to the Hotel das Weitzer (stop: Südtiroler Platz). The price for a one-way trip is € 2,10.

Alternatively you can take a taxi from the airport to your hotel, the average price of the trip from the airport will be about € 25, depending on the traffic and the time of arrival.

Hospitality

Lunch and coffee breaks will be provided to partners from May 14th – 16th, networking dinners will be offered on May 14th and 15th to partners. Participants are asked to indicate any special dietary requirements or allergies in the presence sheet that will be sent out in the beginning of 2014.
