Transportation

The best way to arrive to Graz is by airplane to Graz airport, which is located not so far from downtown. The distance from airport Graz to the event location is about 9 km. You can take a public bus from the airport to the city center or to the main railway station in Graz (bus routes $630/631 \rightarrow \frac{1}{2}$ http://www.verbundlinie.at/busbahnbim-auskunft/pdf/j13/stv 00u613 j13.pdf). The bus stop is







right outside the passenger terminal, right next to the arrival area. Once you are at the city centre (Jakominiplatz) or the main railway station, you can take a tram (No. 1,3,6,7) to the event location (stop: Main Square, Congress Center). The price for a one-way trip is € 2,10.

Alternatively you can take a taxi from the airport, the average price of the trip from the airport will be about € 25, depending on the traffic and the time of arrival.
